



RESOLUCION

TO EXPRESS THE SATISFACTION OF THE GOVERNMENT AND PEOPLE OF THE CAPITAL OF PUERTO RICO ON THE APPOINTMENT OF THE HONORABLE JESUS T. PIÑERO AS GOVERNOR OF PUERTO RICO; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, yesterday, July 25, 1946, the Honorable Harry S. Truman, President of the United States of America, appointed the Honorable Jesus T. Piñero, to the office of Governor of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the appointment of Jesus T. Piñero is an acknowledgment of his undeniable merits and of the right of the People of Puerto Rico to have a governor supported by the great masses of the people;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Jesus T. Piñero is and has always been one of the foremost leaders in the struggle for the rights and justice owing to and merited by our people, and has always distinguished himself by his lofty patriotism and dedication in all such struggles;

WHEREAS, this Administrative Board feels that a public demonstration of the immense satisfaction that pervades the Government and People of the Capital should be made in view of said appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CAPITAL, ASSEMBLED IN SPECIAL SESSION, THIS 26TH DAY OF JULY, 1946:-

Section 1.- That public expression is hereby made of the immense satisfaction felt by the Government and People of the Capital of Puerto Rico on the appointment of Jesus T. Piñero as Governor of Puerto Rico.

Section 2.- That congratulatory cables be sent to the Honorable Harry S. Truman, President of the United States of America, the Honorable Julius Krug, Secretary of the Interior, and the Honorable Jesus T. Piñero.

Section 3.- That copies of this Resolution be sent to the Honorable Harry S. Truman, President of the United States; to the Honorable Kenneth Mc Kellar and Sam Rayburn, Acting President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United States, respectively; to the Honorable Julius Krug, Secretary of the Interior; Jesús T. Piñero, Resident Commissioner of Puerto Rico in Washington; Luis Muñoz Marín, President of the Senate; Francisco M. Susoni, Speaker of the House of Representatives of Puerto Rico; and to the Honorable Manuel A. Pérez, Acting Governor of Puerto Rico; as well as to the press and radio for its publication.

JOSEFINA RINCON MARRERO, SECRETARY OF THE CAPITAL OF PUERTO RICO,-

CERTIFIES that the foregoing is a true and faithful translation of the Resolution passed by the Administrative Board of the Capital on its ordinary meeting held on July 26, 1946, with the affirmative votes of its members, Messrs. Salvador V. Caro, Director of Public Works; Juan A. Pons, Director of Health and Sanitation, and Mr. Angel Diez de Andino, acting as City Manager, School Director and Treasurer of the Capital, as well as Chairman of the Board.
