Know Ye, that, reposing special trust and confidence in the Integrity, Ability and Discretion of
Jesus C. Piñero of Puerto Rico

I have nominated and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate
I do appoint him to be Governor of Puerto Rico

and do authorize and empower him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office according to law, and
to hold the said Office, with all the rights and emoluments thereunto legally appertaining, during the
pleasure of the President of the United States for the time being.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the
Department of the Interior to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this first day of August
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-six and of the
Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and seventy-first
